

# **CNR CLYDE** (excert from the Clyde History Book)

The Canadian Northern Railway's (CNoR) main line reached Edmonton from Winnipeg in late 1905. A 21.6 mile branch from west Edmonton to Morinville opened for service on December 10, 1906. Further work–bound for Athabasca Landing—was stalled by the financial recession of 1907-1908. Work commenced on June 1, 1909, but suffered several delays due to wet weather, and a scarcity of labor. Track laying commenced from Morinville in early July 1911 and finally reached Athabasca Landing on May 14, 1912. The 74.41 mile line from Morinville to Athabasca opened for service on August 6, 1912.
